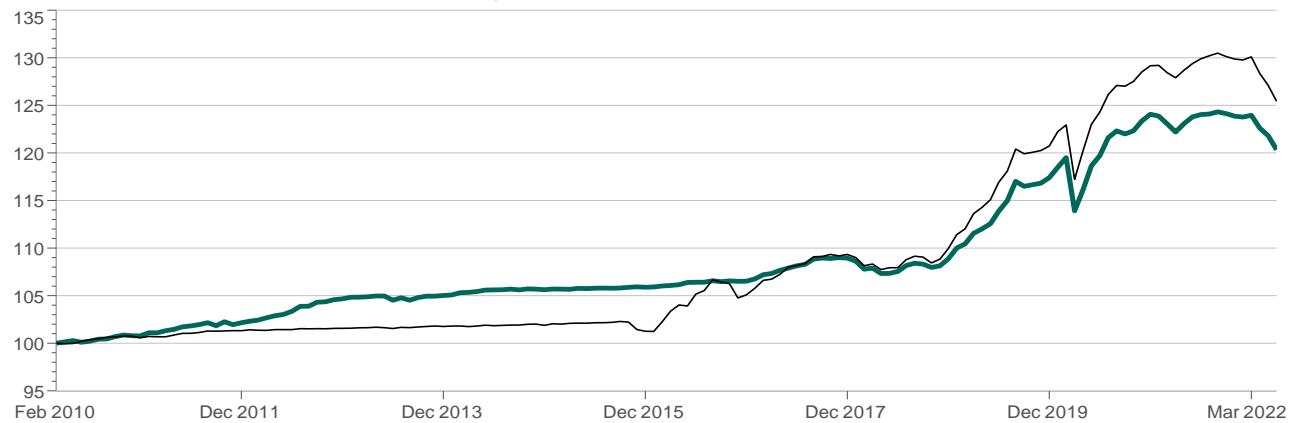

March 2010 - March 2022 (Single Computation)

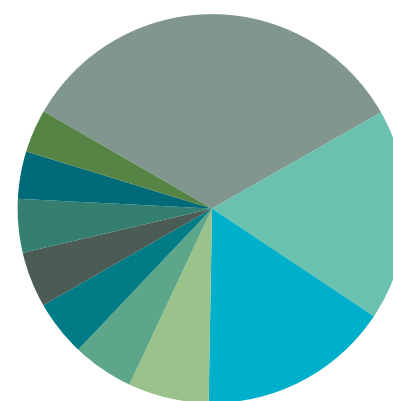

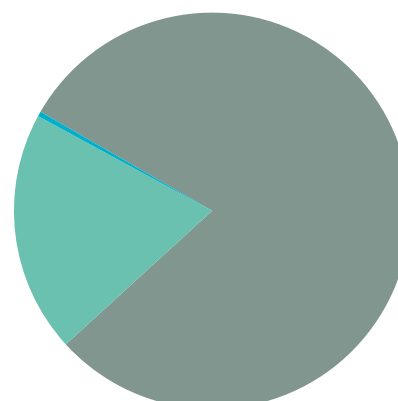
